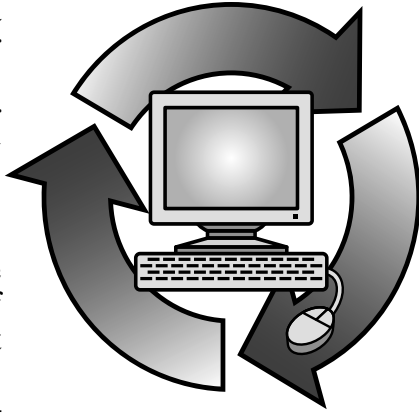

# Goodwill takes on e-cycling

Goodwill Industries of Kanawha Valley, Inc., has kicked off a major partnership with Dell. Called RECONNECT, it is a free drop-off program for consumers who want to responsibly recycle ANY brand of unwanted computer equipment.



The program is presently available in 18 states, plus the District of Columbia. With the addition of West Virginia the program will provide 451 new donation sites in seven states – Colorado, Illinois, Indiana, Missouri, New Mexico, Oklahoma, Wisconsin and now West Virginia.

The RECONNECT Recycling Program accepts the donation of any used computer and/or related computer equipment including: monitors, desktop & laptop computers, printers, scanners, external and internal hard drives, keyboards, mice, speakers, cords, cables and software.

Collected equipment is reconditioned for parts and/or recycled for raw materials. All materials collected for RECONNECT will be recycled to the highest and most environmentally sound end and all proceeds from RECONNECT donations will be used to help support Goodwill's mission to put people to work.

West Virginians in the greater Kanawha Valley can drop off unwanted or unneeded computers and computer equipment at any of the nine store attended donation centers in the area. By donating you are protecting the environment and benefitting surrounding communities – one job at a time.
